## STUDENT PILOT RECRUITMENT 2014

### Minimum Qualification Requirement

1. Thai nationality.
2. Age not over 28 years (Date of Birth from 1 Jan 1986 onwards).
3. Exempted from military service.
4. Minimum height 163 cms.
5. Excellent health and good eyesight (Lasik or PRK is accepted only more than 1 year)
6. University graduate with a Bachelor Degree.
7. Good command of spoken and written English.
8. TOEIC score (550 minimum or equivalent) Valid until 31 DEC 2014
9. No criminal records at Royal Thai Police. Should any criminal or drunk driving records be found and such actions are considered harmful to the air safety or immoral to the pilot career, the company reserves the right to disqualify the candidate.

Applicants are to follow the below instructions:

### STEP 1: E-Application

1. Application is to be made via website [www.thaiairasia.co.th/pilot](http://www.thaiairasia.co.th/pilot) only.
2. Each Applicant must upload the required document upon applying. The following documents are:
  - Identity Card
  - Transcript or copy of bachelor's degree certificate or equivalent
  - Pay-in slip (application fee of THB1000) Payment shall be made at any Kasikorn Bank branch.
3. After completed, applicant will receive the Application's ID. This application's ID can be printed out only when finished submitting the application fee.
4. The non-refundable application fee is THB 1000. After transferring, the applicant should upload the transaction via internet again so the application's ID can be printed out. (The application fee must be paid during June 1-30, 2014 and all documents must be uploaded within June 31, 2014 at 12.00 p.m.
5. Each applicant should carry the application's ID and Two colored one-inch photos throughout the recruitment process.



## STEP 2: Basic Knowledge Test

1. The following documents are required to check before the test.
  - Application's ID
  - Identity card
  - Pay-in slip (application fee of THB1000) Payment shall be made at any Kasikorn Bank branch.
2. Applications will be given three sets of tests:
  - Tests of subject areas essential in pilot work namely Mathematics and Physics (Logics, Natural Science, Technical, Perceptual and Spatial). [100 questions]
  - English Knowledge Test that involves testing applicants' ability to listening and reading comprehension. [100 questions]
  - Basic Aptitude Test such as Speed of Perception, Spatial Orientation, Memory, Logical Thinking Test. [100 questions]
3. Applicants must be at the test room on time. They must be properly attired, carry their applicant's ID, identity card. Writing instruments will be provided. The personal belongings are not allowed in the test room such as computers, calculators, mobile phones and other.
4. Results of the Basic Knowledge Test will be announced via [www.thaiairasia.co.th/pilot](http://www.thaiairasia.co.th/pilot)
5. Applicants must pass the Basic Knowledge Test in order to qualify for step3, Interview.

## STEP 3: Interview

1. The following documents are to be submitted with original and one copy:
  - 2 of one-inch Colored photos (*Taken within three months prior to the application date*)
  - 1 copy for Thai national Identity Card or Government Employee Card.
  - 1 copy for House Registration Certificate.
  - 1 copy for Document of exemption from military service.
  - 1 copy for Transcript and Degree Certificate.
  - 1 copy for TOEIC score (550 minimum or equivalent) Valid until 31 DEC 2014
2. Applicants will be interviewed by the Thai AirAsia Pilot Selection Committee.
3. Applicants must be at the meeting room on time. They must be properly attired.
4. Results of the interview will be announced via [www.thaiairasia.co.th/pilot](http://www.thaiairasia.co.th/pilot)



#### STEP 4: Medical Examination

1. Applicants will be required to undergo a medical examination at 3<sup>rd</sup> floor room1, Institute of Aviation Medicine, Royal Thai Air Force (a four-storey building on the left of Bhumiphol Hospital), 171 Phaholyotin Road, Bangkok 10220
2. Aviation Psychological Group Test
  - The test will be held at 3<sup>rd</sup> floor room1, the institute of Aviation Medicine, Royal Thai Air Force during 08.00-12.00 a.m. The pilot candidates are recommended to have their breakfast and be at the test room not later than 07.30 a.m.
  - They must bring along their applicant's ID, identity cards, one colored one inch of photo and writing instruments.
  - A non-refundable test fee of **THB 5,950** per person will be paid by each pilot candidate on the day of the test. The detail as below;  
**THB3,200**  
The test including Physical examination by physician, Blood pressure, Pulse, Body Weight, Body Height, Audiogram, Chest X ray, Dental Examination, Electrocardiogram, Eye exam, Visual Acuity, Intraocular tension, Color vision, Heterophonies, Visual Field, Depth Perception, Point of convergence accommodation, Slit lamp, Seated Leg Length, Seated Thigh Length, Sitting Height, Laboratory Findings, CBC, Glucose, BUN, Creatinine, Uric Acid, Cholesterol, Triglyceride, HDL, LDL, Protein, Albumin, Bilirubin, SGOT, SGPT, Alkaline phosphatase, VDRL, Urinalysis, HBsAg, HIV, Pulmonary function test.  
**THB 1,250**  
The Drug test such as Morphine, Methamphetamine, Cocaine, Cannabinoid, Phencyclidine.  
**THB 1,500**  
The Aviation Psychological Test.
3. A non-refundable test fee will be paid by each pilot candidate on the day of the test. (Prices can be changed without notice prior to Institute of Aviation Medicine)
4. Preparation guideline for the medical examination is to abstain from food 12 hours (after 2400 hours) prior to the medical examination. A small amount of water may be consumed, if absolutely necessary.
5. Applicants, who ever have Lasik or PRK surgery, should bring your doctor certificate to show before medical examination.
6. Applicants must be in proper attire, bring along their applicant's ID, identity card, one colored one inch of photo and writing instruments.

#### STEP 5: Aviation Psychological Test

The Physical and Mental Check comprises the following:

1. Aviation Psychological Group Test 6 October 2014
  - The test will be held at 3<sup>rd</sup> floor room1, the institute of Aviation Medicine, Royal Thai Air Force during 08.00-12.00 a.m. The pilot candidates are recommended to have their breakfast and be at the test room not later than 07.30 a.m.
  - Applicants must bring along their applicant's ID, identity cards, one colored one inch of photo and writing instruments.
  - The receipt will be shown before the test.



2. Aviation Psychological Individual Test 6-24 October 2014

- The interview will be arranged by Medical Psychologists. One day consists of 20 applicants.
